On Monday 14th September, CTC was fortunate to be involved in the inaugural "All Walks and Wheels Disability Awareness Event" organised by Tina Torrens of Torokit and sponsored by a variety of local services and businesses.

From 12noon until 4.30 pm the forecourt of the Kingaroy Town Hall was home to a variety of stalls and activities based on raising awareness of the challenges and achievements of people with varying abilities. CROSB and Gumnut Place both had stalls promoting services on offer.

Jodi Elkington-Jones (Commonwealth Gold Medalist in 2014 for long jump) made an inspiring and relatable speech about the passion that has guided her through the challenges of living with Cerebral Palsy and pushed her to achieve her very best in the sporting arena.

Gumnut Place and Kingaroy Kitchen had samples for tasting and the CROSB Crew Relay For Life Team sausage sizzle and hamburger stand raised a respectable \$195 for Cancer Research.

There were cooking demonstrations and entertaining games aimed at breaking down stigma and barriers while giving the wider community a better understanding of those with a disability. Overall the day was a resounding success.

Nanango Heritage Lodge Good Neighbours Project



South Burnett CTC is working in partnership with Nanango Heritage Community Funding Ltd, South Burnett Regional Council and the Queensland State Government on the Nanango Heritage Lodge Good Neighbours Project.

The Good Neighbour concept which will be implemented at Heritage Lodge allows a person with a disability or mobility issue to live independently in their own unit. A “good neighbour” will also live in the complex with the expectation that they will be just that, a good neighbour to the other tenants.

Heritage Lodge eventually will be made up of six duplexes. The main target group for tenants will be people who are over 25 living with a disability or mobility issue with a current parent carer who is aged over 65 years, however tenants will not be restricted to only these ages.

The project has now progressed and we have concrete, structures, roofs and walls starting to spring up at a great pace. We are working towards an opening in February 2016 but are still very keen to gather interest from everyone and anyone interested in accessing this form of housing as a tenant or a good neighbour.
