Recipe of the Month - Barbecue pork balls

Ingredients

- * 500g pork mince
- * 1 egg, lightly whisked
- * 2 tablespoons barbecue sauce
- 2 teaspoons finely grated fresh ginger
- * 1 cup panko breadcrumbs
- Vegetable oil, to deep-fry
- Baby cos lettuce leaves, to serve
- Coarsely grated carrot, to serve
- * Barbecue sauce, extra to serve

Method

- Line a baking tray with baking paper. Combine the mince, egg, barbecue sauce, ginger and 15g of the breadcrumbs in a large bowl. Season. Roll 3-teaspoon portions of the mince mixture into balls. Roll in remaining breadcrumbs to coat. Place on prepared tray. Cover and place in the fridge for 30 minutes to rest
- * Add enough oil to a wok to reach a depth of 6cm. Heat to 180oc over medium-high heat. Cook the meatballs in 3 batches, turning occasionally, for 5 minutes or until crisp and golden. Transfer to a plate lined with paper towel.
- * Serve on lettuce leaves with carrot and extra barbecue sauce.
