



VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY **CTC Volunteer Learner Driver Mentor Program**

The CTC Volunteer Learner Driver Mentor Program assists young people in the South Burnett aged 16 to 25 years who:-

- Have a learners licence
- Do not have access to a car and/or licensed person to support them to gain their log book hours to transition to a provisional licence
- Have completed 5 lessons with a Qualified Driving Instructor
- Are deemed “program ready” by their Qualified Driving Instructor

The unfunded program uses a fully insured designated vehicle (a manual Mazda 2, kindly donated and maintained by Bill Hull Car Centre) and relies on people who voluntarily give their time (supported by CTC staff) to mentor young people to improve their technical driving skills and knowledge of road rules and safety as they accumulate their log book hours.

To ensure the success of the program, Mentors must:

- Have a genuine desire to voluntarily give their time to assist with the program
- Have held a current Queensland open manual driver’s licence for at least 1 year
- Demonstrate a good driving history (potentially through providing a traffic history report paid for by CTC)
- Hold a Blue Card for Working with Children and/or a Disability Services Positive Exemption Notice Card (or eligibility to acquire)
- Successfully complete an induction process into the program
- Work within the program Code of Conduct
